

Senior School European History Tour announced

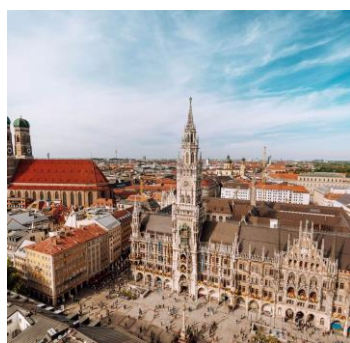

The tour will take place in the school holidays from Wednesday 10 – Wednesday 24 January and will include Germany and Italy, visiting the cities of Berlin, Nuremberg, Munich, Rome and the Bay of Naples, in particular Pompeii and Herculaneum.
