1. Introduction

2. Staging of Construction

The works will be delivered in two stages, as described below.

3. Work to be carried out at each stage

Work & other activities to be carried out at each stage are described below.

Stage 1

- Remediation works to 30-32 Redmyre Rd
- Demolish 30-32 Redmyre Rd apartment building
- Relocate demountable classrooms from Selbourne Oval to 30-32 Redmyre (outside of SSDA approval)
- Construct DaCA building and landscaping works (excluding 30-32 Redmyre Rd works)
- Remove demountable classrooms
- Complete 30-32 Redmyre Rd Works

Stage 2

- Demolish pool and previous DaCA Building
- Construct new social sciences building & associated works including landscaping

4. Compliance with Conditions of Consent across stages

Two independent project stages are proposed. Because these project stages will not be constructed concurrently, the relevant SSD conditions of consent will be applied to, and satisfied for, for each of the two stages independently.

Only the below two conditions are unique to their respective project stages;

Conditions applicable to Stage 1 only

All conditions relating to the Redmyre Road bus zone relocation or extension

Condition applicable to Stage 2 only

Conditions relating to removal of the swimming pool

Notification of the commencement will be provided separately for each stage in accordance with the relevant conditions.

All reports, management plans and the like required for the CC and/or OC of any stage will be prepared separately for each Stage in accordance with the relevant conditions including consultation and approval processes.

*30-32 Redmyre Road will be utilised for construction site establishment during construction of the DaCA and will therefore not be ready for handover with the main build. Upon completion of the DaCA 30-32 Redmyre Rd landscaping works will recommence and be carried out to completion.

6. Compliance with Conditions of Consent across staged operations

As stated above, Stage 1 (the DaCA and 30-32 Redmyre Rd works) will be occupied on a staged basis. The relevant SSD conditions of consent will be satisfied prior to issue of the occupation certificate for each stage.

7. Compliance with independent auditing requirements

Agreement of the Planning Secretary will, in turn, be sought separately for each of the two stages, with Independent Audit Programs prepared for each stage in accordance with the Conditions of Consent.

Independent audits will be carried out for each stage in accordance with the Independent Audit Post Approval Requirements (2020).

All Conditions relating to Independent Audits will be met separately for each of the two project stages.

8. Cumulative impacts associated with proposed staging

Because there is no concurrence between the two project stages, no cumulative impacts are forseen to arise from the proposed staging
