

A proposed new Aquatic Centre

We are excited to share our plans to build a new Aquatic Centre at 12-14 Margaret and 16 Margaret Street, Strathfield. This new centre will enable Meriden to continue offering a high standard of sport facilities for generations of girls to come.

Meriden is seeking approval from the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI), to build the Aquatic Centre. The project includes:

- Demolishing:
 - the existing residential flat building at 12-14 Margaret Street
 - the existing administration building at 16 Margaret Street.
- Excavating:
 - 12-14 Margaret Street to create two basement levels
 - A section of the Lingwood campus, to create two basement levels to connect to the two levels of basement at 12-14 Margaret Street.
- Building the new Aquatic Centre, with spectator seating and ancillary amenities, such as staff and student change rooms, and a first aid room. The new pool will be built on the basement level, so the building appears as a one storey above-ground building.
- Tree removal and landscaping.
- Installation of a new kiosk substation.
