

2026 Senior School Athletic Carnival

Congratulations to all the girls who participated in the 2026 Senior School Athletics Carnival.

It was a successful day of fun and competition, and it was wonderful to see so many students participating across a wide range of events. Highlights of the day included the House and Class relays, along with the Fastest 10 over 100 metres.

There were many strong performances throughout the day, with two school records broken. Mia Brown (Year 7 Lincoln) set a new record in the 12 Years 100 metres, and Annika Kumar (Year 7 Durham) broke the Junior 400 metres record, with both girls bettering the previous records set in 2024 by over half a second.

Once again, in the hotly contested Fastest 10 over 100 metres, the final came down to Olivia Achike (Year 11 Oxford) and Emmanuella Omege (Year 12 Sussex). After a dead heat in 2024 and finishing runner-up in 2025, Emmanuella was victorious in 2026, claiming the title in her final year.

Outstanding individual performances came from Amber Worden (Year 9 York), who won four individual titles, along with Sienna Sukh (Year 10 Cambridge) and Annika Kumar, who each secured three first-place finishes across their events.

In the Open House Relay, Cumberland House stormed home to defeat two-time defending champions Oxford, with York finishing third.

Warwick House won both the Year 7/Year 8 and Year 9/Year 10 Class Relays, while Cumberland took out the Year 11/Year 12 relay. Olivia and Ella Achike (Oxford) once again claimed victory in the Sisters Relay.

Other highlights included a vibrant dance performance from the Year 12 cohort, showcasing a range of costumes, along with another win over staff in the Year 12 versus Staff Relay. Thank you to all staff who participated.

This year, Cumberland House once again claimed the overall title of House Champions, with Year 10 Cumberland winning the Class Cup for the highest participation points.

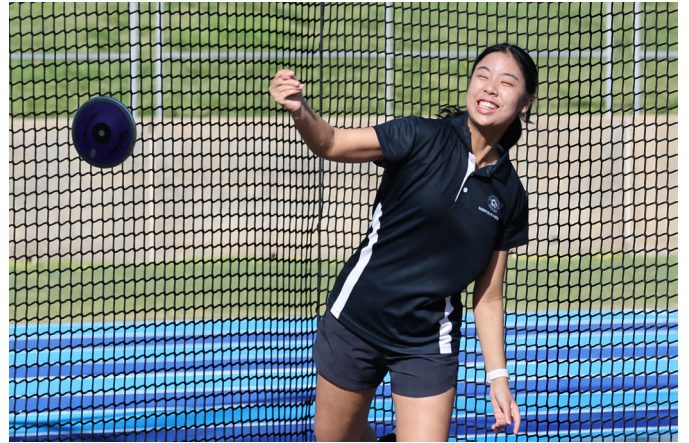
